EDUCATION STRATEGY

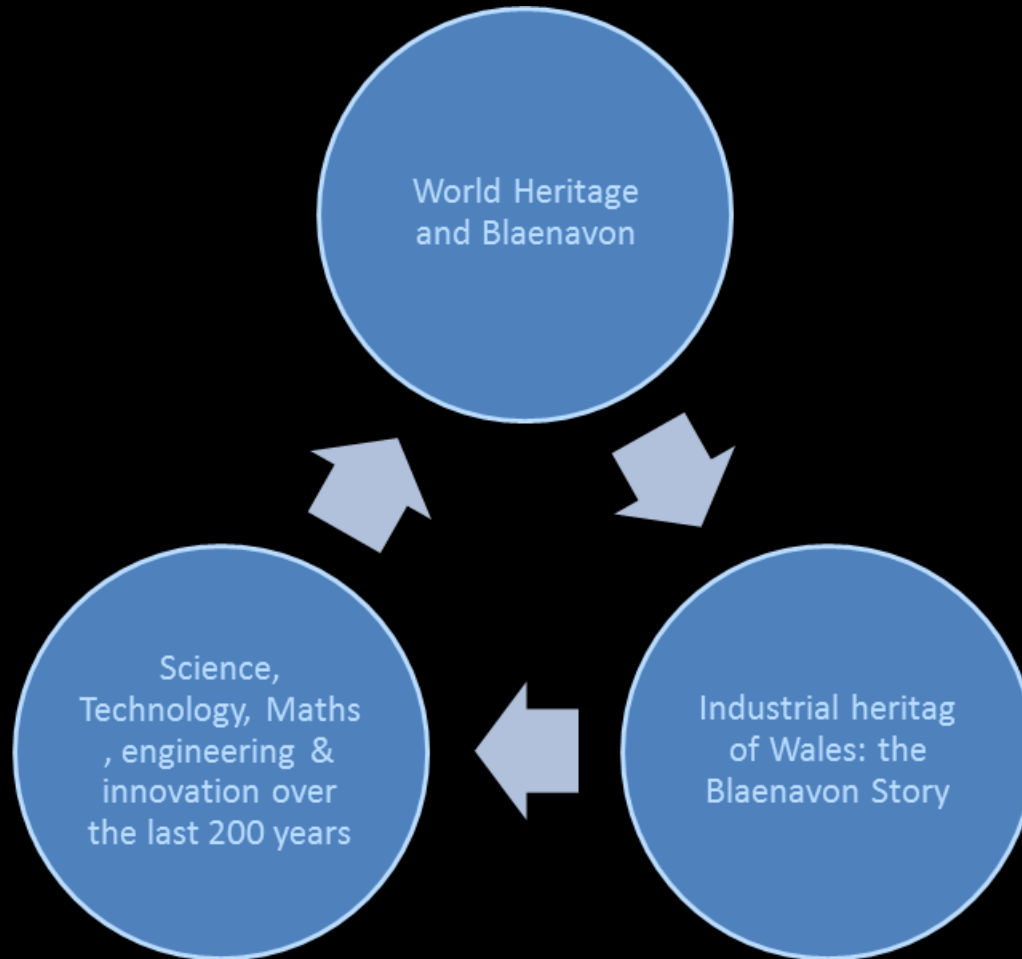
