Blaenavon Volunteers Win Prestigious National Award

Gwirfoddolwyr Blaenavon yn ennill Gwobr Genedlaethol Fawr



The volunteers of the Blaenavon Community Museum have been awarded the Marsh Volunteers for Museum Learning Awards for both Wales and the United Kingdom. The team was presented with the prestigious awards at the British Museum at a special event held on 26 September attended by representatives from museums across the country.

The awards are run in partnership between the Marsh Christian Trust and the British Museum and recognise best practice and the most innovative ways in which volunteers engage the public with collections. The national UK award is presented where a tangible difference to the public offer has been made in a museum and where a unique dimension to that offer has been introduced.

On presenting the national award to the volunteers, Brian Marsh OBE, Chairman of the Marsh Christian Trust, said:

'Your work in facilitating the relocation of the Blaenavon Community Museum, and your efforts to increase the profile of the museum in the tourism industry, was considered by the judging panel as exceptional.'

In acknowledgement of their achievements, the volunteers were awarded a cheque for £2,500 and were treated to free tickets to the British Museum's incredible 'Sunken Cities' exhibition.

Blaenavon World Heritage Site Represents UK at the European Association of World Heritage

In October this year Blaenavon World Heritage Site was given the privilege of representing the UK at the European World Heritage Association at their 2nd annual meeting in Segovia, Spain. The World Heritage Youth Ambassadors is a project, funded by Heritage Lottery, that is designed to empower young people aged 13-25 to have a voice and participate in the management of their World Heritage Site.

After achieving national success and recognition for this project, Blaenavon was asked to be the UK's representative for World Heritage Sites to present best practise on youth engagement.

The meeting brought together over 50 World Heritage Sites from across Europe to share best practice regarding World Heritage and local communities, participation processes, social bonds and innovation.

Ashleigh Taylor, Heritage Officer and Daniel Oliver, Youth Ambassador Project Officer attended the prestigious conference and presented to the association "How to involve and allow youth participation in the management of World Heritage". Feedback from other World Heritage Sites said that Blaenavon was inspiring and leading the way!

Community Unites to Save Historic Mansion

Members of the Blaenavon community have formed a new group to consider the future of one of the World Heritage Site's most important buildings. The former Beeches Nursing Home, also known as Blaenavon House or Ty Mawr, has been a cause for concern since the building closed as a residential home a decade ago. The privately owned, grade-II listed building has suffered vandalism, fire damage and neglect in recent years. It is in a very dangerous condition and presents a major conservation challenge.

The new group, working closely with Torfaen County Borough Council, aims to form a Building Preservation Trust which will seek to identify a new, sustainable use for the building and to attract grant funding for its restoration. It is not going to be an easy task and there are no guarantees that the group will succeed. Indeed, many challenges lie ahead but the community is not prepared to give up on this historic and much-loved building.

In the coming months, the group aims to formalise its structure and work with relevant heritage and conservation organisations to develop an action plan for the project. Blaenavon House: A Potted History

Blaenavon House, known informally as the 'Great House' or 'Ty Mawr', has had many functions throughout its history. The 'comfortable and elegant' mansion was built in about 1799 by the ironmaster Samuel Hopkins, who lived there until his death in 1815. The house then became the residence of Thomas Hill II and his children before it was sold, along with the Blaenavon Ironworks, to the new Blaenavon Iron and Coal Company in 1836.

The building was extended by 1839 and was used as a hunting lodge. Dignitaries from far afield would stay there every August whilst enjoying the popular grouse hunts on the Blaenavon landscape. Blaenavon House continued to be used as a private dwelling by various general managers and directors of the new company, including the Kennard family.

In the 1920s, the Blaenavon Company sold the mansion to the Blaenavon Medical Aid Society, who converted the building into a hospital in 1927. Managed by the workers, and financed through their subscriptions, the medical scheme was among those which helped inspire the National Health Service. The building ceased to be a hospital in 1980 and eventually became a nursing home.

Mae'r grŵp newydd, sy'n cydweithio'n agos gyda Chyngor Bwrdeistref Sirol Torfaen, yn anelu i ffurfio Ymddiriedolaeth Cadwraeth, i geisio canfod defnydd newydd, cynaliadwy ar gyfer yr adeilad ac i ddenu arian grant i'w adfer. Nid yw'n mynd i fod yn dasg hawdd ac nid oes sicrwydd y bydd y grŵp yn llwyddo. Yn wir, mae llawer o heriau o'u blaenau ond nid yw'r gymuned yn barod i roi'r ffordd i y to o ran yr adeilad hanesyddol a hoffus hwn.

Yn y misoedd i ddod, mae'r grŵp yn anelu i ffurfioli ei strwythur a gweithio gyda sefydliadau treftadaeth a chadwraeth berthnasol i ddatblygu cynllun gweithredu ar gyfer y prosiect. Blaenavon House: Crynodeb o'i Hanes

Mae Blaenavon House, a elwir yn anffurfiol yn 'Great House' neu 'Ty Mawr', wedi cael llawer o swyddogaethau drwy gydol ei hanes. Adeiladwyd y plasty 'cyfforddus a choeth' tua 1799 gan y meistr haearn Samuel Hopkins, fu'n byw yno hyd ei farwolaeth yn 1815. Yna daeth yn gartref i Thomas Hill II a'i blant cyn iddo gael ei werthu, ynghyd â Gwaith Haearn Blaenafon, i gwmni newydd Blaenavon Iron and Coal Company ym 1836.

Cafodd yr adeilad ei ymestyn erbyn 1839 a'i ddefnyddio fel llety hela. Byddai urddolion o bell yn aros yno bob mis Awst wrth fwynhau'r helfeydd rugiar poblogaidd ar dirwedd Blaenafon. Parhaodd Blaenavon House i gael ei ddefnyddio fel annedd breifat gan wahanol reolwyr a chyfarwyddwyr cyffredinol y cwmni newydd, gan gynnwys teulu Kennard.

Yn y 1920au, gwerthodd Blaenavon Company y plasty i Gymdeithas Cymorth Feddygol Blaenafon, a aeth ati i drosi'r adeilad yn ysbyty ym 1927. Dan reolaeth y gweithwyr, a'i ariannu drwy eu tanysgrifiadau, roedd y cynllun meddygol ymhlith y rhai a gynorthwyodd i ysbrydoli'r Gwasanaeth Iechyd Gwladol. Daeth gyfnod yr adeilad i ben fel ysbyty ym 1980 ac yn y diwedd daeth yn gartref nyrsio.

Rediscovered Portraits Provide Glimpse into Blaenavon's Past

Fourteen portraits have recently been rediscovered in the cellar of the Blaenavon Workmen's Hall, depicting local people who played a prominent role in the community during the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries.

Most of the portraits were donated to the hall before 1918. It is believed they were moved into the cellar for safekeeping during renovation work decades ago and forgotten about until they were found by long-serving volunteer Mike Parry earlier this year.

The images depict local dignitaries from the early 1900s, including local politicians, magistrates, and trustees of the Workmen's Institute. The repair, redisplay and interpretation of the portraits have been funded by the Blaenavon Community Museum and now visitors can glimpse at these long forgotten faces from Blaenavon's past.

Dr Nathan Matthews of the Blaenavon Community Museum said: "these beautifully produced photographs provide an important reminder of the individuals involved in the social and political life of Blaenavon during the early 20th century. They offer evidence of the social enterprise of the workers and the strength of Liberalism and political radicalism in the area before the First World War. It is great to see these portraits on display at the hall, where they belong."
